

## Assign EFL Examples

**Scenario 1:** A continuing student who did not have an NRS test during the 90-day lookback window:


This is a continuing student who started a new class on 7/6/20 and received 2 contact hours in Web Attendance:



The student's last NRS test was on 1/15/2020:



Since the student has hours for attending the 2020-21 class on 7/6/2020, a POP for PY 2021 was generated:



This student has not taken an NRS test during the 90-day lookback period. Now that a new POP for 2021 has generated, I can drill in and "assign EFL"

<u>Scenario 2:</u> A student who did take an NRS test during the 90-day lookback period and is continuing into the new 2020-21 program year.

You will not see the test pull forward until the student registers for a class on or after 7/1/2020 and receives hours in Web Attendance. As soon as the student receives attendance hours during the 2020-21 program year, the test that was taken during the 90 day look back period, will pull into the new program year

Also, please note that you must run XLEULT before you can enter test scores for the 2020-21 program year.
