**Overdue Notice Headers****Deborah Foster**

The Lending Services committee, after surveying CCLINC colleges for input, approved the addition of several new overdue notice headers for WorkFlows. When presented to the Steering Committee, John noted that one of the headers was too lengthy and recommended that it be shortened. Deborah is working on the text of the notice and will submit all notices to the Steering Committee for final approval at the next meeting.

**Upgrade for Thelma****John Wood**

Thelma (Test Server) will be down Thursday, August 7th in order to upgrade the operating system to Solaris 10. **This will not affect any activity on our live server or in iLink.** There are several enhancements that the Steering Committee will need to vote on. John will send a list to the committee before the next meeting. After the upgrade, WorkFlows GL3.1 (Java Client) will become Symphony 3.2. **Client Care****John Wood**

SIRSI has made changes to the Client Care website. All of the logins for the community colleges have had to be re-done. John sent out a memo to CCLINC directors and SAs in late June to ask for a contact name and valid e-mail address from one person at each school.

**DELETEME Proposal****Roxanne Davenport**

Roxanne had submitted a proposal for shortening the duration of time that we are unable to put things in DELETEME at fiscal year-end. John stated that it only takes him two to four days to run the purge of items that are in that location. The Steering Committee had made the decision early on after migrating to SIRSI in 2000 that we should give the colleges time (the full month of July) to run all of their reports before John could do the purge. Now that we have been on SIRSI for eight years, most colleges are more efficient with reports and do not need as much time. Because Roxanne was not present to participate in the discussion, Deborah Foster made the motion that this item be tabled until the next meeting; Allen Mosteller seconded, and all approved.

**Training in Java Client****Ruth Bryan**

Ruth sent out an assessment for training needs and has received good feedback from the colleges. Training in the Java client will be held at the System Office in September, October and early November for circulation, cataloging, reports, reserves and serials, if at least five people sign up.

**Request from Cleveland CC****Allen Mosteller**

Cleveland requested permission to have a mass edit of existing student records for returning students. Student email accounts have been established for the coming semester and to manually edit each returning record would be extremely labor intensive. Cleveland's IT department will populate their ID database and then the user ID will be the match point in WorkFlows. They will produce the file from the ID database and then will send it to John for him to run the report. This is only a one time request to get returning students. Allen Mosteller made the motion that Cleveland be allowed to produce the file and send to John for the mass edit. Deborah Foster seconded, and all approved.

<p>Julia Mielish, Libby Stone, Allen Mosteller, Airen Little and Roxanne Davenport met on July 29<sup>th</sup> to discuss possible solutions for federated searching of NetLibrary titles, e-books, etc. Julia met with Ruth Bryan and John Wood regarding some “free” options using our current iLink system; the committee felt that these options would only be a temporary fix as the issue goes beyond NetLibrary. More and more libraries are purchasing their own e-book collections, electronic databases, and the trend will continue as more and more classes are offered online. The committee came up with several action items; Julia and Roxanne are looking into WorldCat Local, Allen is going to report back on Cleveland’s experiences with Serials Solutions, and Libby is looking into funding options. The committee will meet again on Sept. 26.</p>
