SUBJECT: Pell Grant Verification

As customary at this time of year, your assistance is needed in collecting Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) information and verifying the accuracy of Pell Grant data. Since your Perkins federal basic grant allocations are calculated from this information, please be accurate and clear with your answers. I have given much consideration to allowing vocational/technical students enrolled in AGE and GOT to be counted in Pell totals. However, after reviewing the Perkins Act, I have determined, we still can not use AGE or GOT students in the Pell Counts.

Use the attached Verification Form to report the number of <u>vocational and technical students</u> receiving Pell Grants for the twelve-month period ending with the end of the last summer session in 2007 (Fall semester 2006 Spring and Summer 2007). Colleges using the College Information System should use the following link to access information: http://www.ncccs.edu/CIS_Docs/SharedQueries/sq_FA.html. Colleges still using IIPS can obtain the information using the following: Log to **CC.FA** and execute **NCHED.MAJOR**. There should be three reports produced: "Unduplicated Count of Major Types for Pell for Year 2007," "Unduplicated Count of (A10) College Transfer Students for Pell" and "Unduplicated Count of A55280 Students for Pell." Use these reports to complete the Verification Form. Students reported should be only those students that actually received Pell dollars.

Return the Pell Grant Verification Form <u>and</u> the three reports as soon as possible, but no later than May 9, 2008.
