SUBJECT: CASAS State-wide Training

Comprehensive Adult Student Assessment System (CASAS) training will be offered at two locations. Fayetteville Technical Community College will host the eastern CASAS training on October 6-8, 2008, and Western Piedmont Community College will host the western CASAS training on October 8-10, 2008.

Training is being conducted by nationally and state certified CASAS trainers who not only offer the necessary training, but also provide ongoing technical assistance and other support services in NC. This important training will offer the opportunity for up to TWO instructors to become recertified or become new local trainers. <u>Individuals attending this</u> training should intend to do training at the local level.

The **first day** of CASAS training will be the "Implementation Training (IT)" with the *Life and Work* series for new users. The IT Training is the pre-requisite for all other offerings. Implementation Training will be offered the first day from 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

On the **second day**, the specialized assessment training offered is:

- 1) Developmental Disability (DD) training for those who work with Compensatory Education (9:00 a.m. 12:00 p.m.), at each respective location
- 2) English as a Second Language (ESL) training for those who work with ESL (1:00 p.m. 4:00 p.m.), at each respective location

On the **third day**, "Beyond Implementation Training (BIT)" will be offered for those current users who have completed the initial CASAS IT workshop and have hands-on experience with CASAS testing at their local agency and now are needing the required every two-year refresher and update training. This is being offered from 9 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. CC08 -205

Directions to Fayetteville Technical Community College

Coming South on I-95 from the Triangle or Raleigh area

Take I 40 east and then take I-95 south. Take 301 exit or the first exit to Fayetteville. Turn right on Grove Street. You will dead end on Bragg Blvd. Turn right on Bragg Blvd. Take Bragg Blvd. to Barrington Cross. Turn left on Barrington Cross and go through one stoplight. Go to next stoplight and you are on campus.

Coming North on I-95 from Lumberton area

Take the Route 87 exit. Stay on 87 and you will be on the Martin Luther King Highway. Take the Route 24 exit. Turn left at the overpass. You will be entering Bragg Blvd. Take the Blvd. to Barrington Cross. Turn left on Barrington Cross and go through one stoplight. At the next stoplight you are on campus.

Coming into Fayetteville on 401 from Raeford

Take 401 until you reach 401 bypass. Turn left on the bypass. Go until you reach Morganton Road. Turn right on Morganton. Go on Morganton until you reach Skye Drive. Take Skye Drive until you reach the first stoplight, you are on campus.

Coming into Fayetteville on Route 87 from the North.

Take Route 87 into Fayetteville until you reach Stamper Road. Turn right on Stamper Road. At the first stop light, FTCC is directly in front of you.


