**SUBJECT: Procedures for Seeking Reimbursement for Instructional Contracts** 

with Local School Administrative Units

On May 7, 2010, Kennon Briggs issued numbered memo CC10-018, which clarified restrictions on instructional contracts with local school administrative units. As explained in that memo, G.S. 115D-41 prohibits a college from generating budget FTE if it contracts with a local school administrative unit for a public high school teacher to teach a college level course. Instead, G.S. 115D-41 provides that the college shall be reimbursed for direct instructional costs contained in the contract plus 15% for administrative costs.

Please note that G.S. 115D-41 does not apply to situations where a college may contract directly with the public high school teacher to teach a college level course. Furthermore, colleges are not eligible to seek reimbursement for general education courses (excluding math, science, and technology), physical education, and college success skills offered to high school students through the dual enrollment and Huskins programs.

Colleges will receive reimbursement in the fiscal year following the fiscal year in which the contract was in force. For example, colleges will be reimbursed in FY 2010-11 for instructional contracts with LEAs in force in FY 2009-10. To receive reimbursement, a college must submit the attached form and a copy of the instructional contract with the local school administrative unit to Tracy Williams Pender (pendert@nccommunitycolleges.edu) by the last working day of July. Reimbursements will be paid to colleges once a year in the month of August unless circumstances delay the System Office's ability to process the reimbursements.
