Subject: Curriculum Review Committee Course Approvals

The Curriculum Review Committee (CRC) has the responsibility for maintaining the curriculum courses in the *Combined Course Library* (CCL). Curriculum Description

The Cosmetology curriculum is designed to provide competency-based knowledge, scientific/artistic principles, and hands-on fundamentals associated with the cosmetology industry. The curriculum provides a simulated salon environment which enables students to develop manipulative skills.

Course work includes instruction in all phases of professional imaging, hair design, chemical processes, skin care, nail care, multi-cultural practices, business/computer principles, product knowledge, and other selected topics.

Graduates should qualify to sit for the State Board of Cosmetic Arts examination. Upon successfully passing the State Board exam, graduates will be issued a license. Employment is available in beauty salons and related businesses.

Curriculum Description

The Occupational Therapy Assistant curriculum prepares individuals to work under the supervision of a registered/licensed occupational therapist in screening, assessing, planning, and implementing treatment and documenting progress for clients receiving occupational therapy services.

Course work includes human growth and development, conditions which interfere with activities of daily living, theory and process of occupational therapy, individual/group treatment activities, therapeutic use of self, activity analysis, and grading/adapting activities and environments.

Graduates may be eligible to take the national certification examination for practice as a certified occupational therapy assistant. Employment opportunities include hospitals, rehabilitation facilities, long-term/extended care facilities, sheltered workshops, schools, home health programs, and community programs.

MAT 271 Calculus I Amended Criteria for Direct Placement

Background: The Curriculum Review Committee (CRC) approved the following criteria for Direct Placement into MAT 271 on May 27, 2015. The highlighted information was added as an amendment to reflect revised SAT scores. The amendment was presented to the CRC for information on May 26, 2016.

A student may place directly into MAT 271 if the student has met at least one (1) of the following criteria within the past five (5) years:

- *A score of 2 or higher on the AP Calculus AB Exam.*
- *A grade of C or higher in an AP Calculus course and an unweighted HS GPA of 3.0 or higher.*
- *A score of 90 or higher on the ACCUPLACER College-Level Math (CLM) test.*
- *A score of 46 or higher on the trigonometry section of the ACT Compass Math Placement Test.*
- *A score of 580 or higher on the old (prior to March 2016) SAT Math and a grade of C or higher in the North Carolina Standard Course of Study Pre-Calculus course or an equivalent course from another state.*
- *A score of 600 or higher on the new (March 2016 and beyond) SAT Math and a grade of C or higher in the North Carolina Standard Course of Study Pre-Calculus course or an equivalent course from another state.*
- *A score of 27 or higher on the ACT Math and a grade of C or higher in the North Carolina Standard Course of Study Pre-Calculus course or an equivalent course from another state.*
- *A score of 560 or higher on the SAT Subject Test in Mathematics Level 2.*

The current version of MAT 272 in the *Combined Course Library* has been updated to reflect the amendment.
