# Updating the North Carolina Statewide High School to Community College Career and Technical Education (CTE) Articulation Agreement

<u>Request:</u> The State Board of Community Colleges is asked to approve updates to the North Carolina High School to Community College CTE Articulation Agreement. The changes are listed in the table that starts on the following page.

<u>Background:</u> The North Carolina High School to Community College Articulation Agreement provides a seamless process that joins secondary and postsecondary Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs of study.

This statewide articulation agreement includes 66 high school CTE courses that match the knowledge and skills taught in similar community college courses. The articulation agreement ensures that if a student is proficient in a certain high school course, the student can receive college credit for that course at any North Carolina community college. This streamlines the student's educational pathway by eliminating the need to pass multiple courses with the same learning outcomes.

In addition to this statewide articulation agreement, local articulation agreements can be developed to build strong partnerships between high schools and individual community colleges. These local articulation agreements respond to new and emerging industries, provide for programs unique to the region, and add articulated courses and pathway alignments at the local level that are not included in the state agreement.

Rationale: Due to course changes at both secondary and postsecondary levels (new courses, archived courses, updated curriculum), the articulation agreement has been periodically updated since the first articulation agreement was established in 1999. This update to the articulation agreement began with recommendations from state-level curriculum consultants from both the NC Department of Public Instruction and the NC Community College System. Under the direction of the community college chief academic officers, subject-matter experts from the community colleges and the public-school units (PSUs) were asked to participate in evaluating course matches. The evaluations considered the course descriptions secondary course blueprints, postsecondary course syllabi, number of classroom and lab hours, and industry credentials associated with the courses to determine the extent of the course. Course matches with a significant match of 80 percent of the material were recommended for inclusion in this agreement. After the evaluation process, a final list of the proposed course matches was sent to the chief academic officers at each college for a final vote. Each course that received two-thirds of votes from colleges approved to offer the courses being considered were included on the final statewide articulation agreement. The chief academic officer for each college will give final approval for articulation credit to be awarded.
