SUBJECT: Proposed Amendment of 1C SBCCC 300.3 – Faculty Standards

DATE: May 20, 2025

On May 16, 2025, the State Board of Community Colleges (SBCC) initiated the rulemaking process to amend **1C SBCCC 300.3 – Faculty Standards**. The proposed amendment would replace all references of Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC) with "institutional accrediting agency" for faculty standards in hiring and teaching. The proposed amendment is published on the NC Community College System's website, Numbered Memos - NCCCS (nccommunitycolleges.edu). For your convenience, a copy of the proposed rule, with the changes indicated, is attached to this memorandum. Strikethroughs indicate deletions of existing language and underlines indicate additions of language.

Any member of the public has the right to submit written comments on the proposed rule. Please note that any person who submits public comments on behalf of their community college should comply with their college's local process for submitting comments on a proposed rule. Written comments on the rule must be received by no later than 5:00 p.m. on June 19, 2025. Any member of the public has the right to request a hearing on the proposed rule. Requests for a hearing must be received by no later than 5:00 p.m. on June 4, 2025.
