SUBJECT: State Board Code Amendment 1G SBCCC 200.96

DATE: July 31, 2025

This memo provides details of an amendment to State Board Code 1G SBCCC 200.96 as approved by the State Board at the July 18, 2025, meeting.

The State Board amended 1G SBCCC 200.96 as follows:

- Removed all existing language in this section of code as it was antiquated and no longer relevant and supportive of our public safety training climates today.
- Added language to support colleges in partnering with state agencies when the agency wishes to utilize our training facilities but will be instructing the course themselves through their agency.
- Added language to support colleges in partnering with local public safety agencies to provide instructors for courses while "on duty" when other instructors are not available following our normal hiring processes.

The amendment to 1G SBCCC 200.96 is effective August 1, 2025.

A professional development session will be forthcoming in the next few weeks on this change with discussion on implementation and best practices. More information to come soon.
