This memo provides updates related to a technical change to course hours for FIP-2146, Fire Protection Systems.

The new Propel Partner course FIP-2146, Fire Protection Systems, approved by the State Board of Community Colleges on May 20, 2025, had an error in the recommended course hours. The System Office has corrected this error and amended the incorrect amount of 64 hours to the correct amount of 80 hours. The effective term of this correction is Summer 2025.
