DATE: November 25, 2025

On November 21, 2025, the State Board of Community Colleges (SBCC) initiated the rulemaking process to amend **2A SBCCC 300.6 – North Carolina Proprietary School Fee Schedule**. The proposed amendment would increase the late license renewal fee for Proprietary Schools from \$500 to \$1,000. This proposed increase would potentially discourage schools from submitting late applications. The proposed amendment is published on the NC Community College System's website, Numbered Memos - NCCCS (nccommunitycolleges.edu). For your convenience, a copy of the proposed rule, with the adopted language indicated, is attached to this memorandum. Strikethroughs indicate deletions of existing language and underlines indicate additions of language.

Any member of the public has the right to submit written comments on the proposed rule. Please note that any person who submits public comments on behalf of their community college should comply with their college's local process for submitting comments on a proposed rule. Written comments on the rule must be received by no later than 5:00 p.m. on December 25, 2025. Any member of the public has the right to request a hearing on the proposed rule. Requests for a hearing must be received by no later than 5:00 p.m. on December 10, 2025.
